If you choose a battle, be sure to tell when, where, who was fighting, important generals, battle strategy, outcome (who won?) and how did it affect the war.

Please do not choose a topic which you did for Pennsylvania History Fair in 4<sup>th</sup> grade. You might want to do some preliminary research to see how difficult it will be to find information on your chosen topic. As noted on the calendar, you have until Feb. 17 to change your topic, provided you bring a note from a parent.
