Dear Kindergarten Families,

I am looking forward to meeting you and working with you during the coming year. It will be an exciting experience for you to see the growth and the learning that will take place as we go through this year.

I would like to share some expectations and suggestions to help make the kindergarten experience a happy one.

- Your child will need to follow a few classroom rules. (These will be shared at Back to School Night.)
- The children should respect their classmates.
- They should learn to accept responsibility for their own actions.
- Use proper “personal care” procedures. (bathroom etiquette)
- Your child will need rain gear. Each child should bring an umbrella. This will be KEPT in school for the year. Raincoats are optional.
- A backpack type book bag is needed. This should be brought to school every day. (It would be handy if the back bag had an outside pocket to carry the water bottle. The school will provide the kindergarten class with water bottles.)
- Your child does NOT need to bring any stationary supplies to school. All supplies will be provided during the year.
- When purchasing shoes, PLEASE be sure your child can manage them. If they are not tying yet, try buckles or Velcro. LOW RUBBER SOLED SHOES would be the safest for the children.
- Please make an effort to attend Back to School Night. Information will be given that night that will answer many of your questions and address your concerns.

As we begin this year together, I would like to encourage you to be active in your child’s education. Be involved! Ask your child about their day, check over the work they bring home, work with them and help when necessary.
