- Monday January 30th: Tournament Day

This event will take place at Lancaster Catholic High School. Your child will be able to participate in a number of rounds at school, to determine if they will be eligible to compete at Lancaster Catholic. Four events will be offered Math 24, Scrabble, a Religion Bee and an Agility Challenge. A Tournament Day will also be offered at Our Lady of the Angels School on Monday January 30th, if your child does not make it through to participate at Lancaster Catholic. Math 24 and Scrabble will be offered at Our Lady of the Angels Tournament Day. Fourth through eighth grade will participate.

- Tuesday January 31st: Team T-shirt Day & Wii Day

Your child will have the opportunity to wear their favorite sports teams' jersey or T-shirt. Any sport applies. Examples being, Soccer, Basketball, Football, Hockey, Baseball and also if your child plays for OLA basketball they may wear their jersey. Fourth through eighth grades will need to wear their jersey or T-shirt over their gym uniform and kindergarten through third will need to wear their jersey over their school uniform. All grades will participate.

- Wednesday, February 1st: ABC Day
