There always seems to be something happening at Our Lady of the Angels and October was no different. We are grateful for all the support that we receive and wish you a Blessed Thanksgiving.

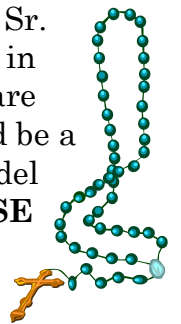


PARENT CONFERENCES

LATE PICK UPS
