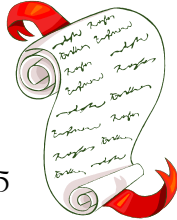

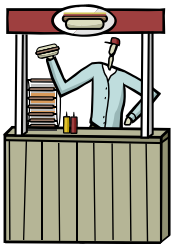
MISSION MONDAYS
