

OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS SCHOOL POLICY

Subject: Admissions Priorities for Students

Admission to Our Lady of the Angels School will be on a space available basis or administrative discretion according to the following priorities.

1. Registered members of Holy Trinity or Saint Peter parishes.
 - a. With siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
 - b. Without siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
2. Catholics registered in other parishes that do not have a school or which can not accommodate the student(s)
 - a. With siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
 - b. Without siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
3. Non-Catholics
 - a. With siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
 - b. Without siblings attending Our Lady of the Angels School
4. The pastors will be responsible for dispute resolution related to these priorities.

Children of non-parishioners who attend Our Lady of the Angels School Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten will not be guaranteed a place in Our Lady of the Angels first grade. Non-parishioners will be admitted to Our Lady of the Angels first grade only after children of parishioners are enrolled. Once a non-parishioner's child is enrolled in first grade that child/ren will be considered permanently enrolled.
